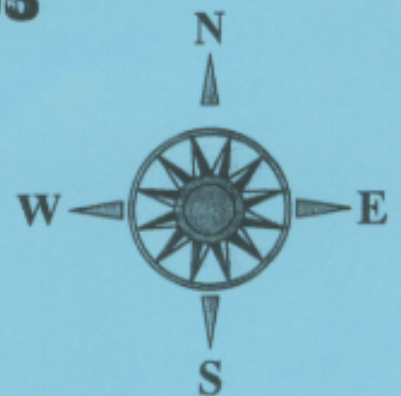

## RUBY RIVER

### CROSS THE CREEK

Patrol members will cross over the icy gorge using hand over hand rope bridge. The goal is to get your patrol and your sled to the other side. Teamwork is most important - show your patrol spirit.

### ICE RESCUE

Using materials that you have brought with you, a member of your patrol has fallen into the gorge and the icy water. You and your team members must get your fallen companion out of the gorge and treat him for hypothermia.

## ATTU

### Slingshot & Archery Hunt

The boys will shoot frozen kibble at pie plates decorated as turkeys. Each boy will have five (5) shots. Each hit will count for points.

The boys will then proceed to hunt for large game with bow & arrow. Each boy will have four (4) shots on target to accumulate additional points.

## SKAGWAY

### Norwegian Skiing

This is a team building event where your patrol will mount a single set of snow skis and travel a designated course. Your patrol must finish together on their skis to gain maximum points. Show your team spirit and your ability to act as one.

### Wildlife Identification

Your patrol will play a wildlife identification game. Each correct answer will gain your patrol points. Do you know what's out there?

## JUNEAU

### Orienteering

Your patrol will get to demonstrate their orienteering skills in this event. They will navigate a course using compass and pace method.

## KODIAK

Survival Skills

Your patrol has been suddenly caught in a snowstorm; you must act fast to take some cover. Using materials in your sled, build a shelter (no tents).

Fire Building Skills

Patrols will have materials needed in their sleds for fires. You will be allowed to use fire by spark, glass, friction, or the one match method to start your fire. No commercial fire starters will be allowed. Your patrol will start a fire and cook an egg inside either an onionskin or an orange peel. The orange or an onion must not be pre-cut.

## NOME

### Blindman Obstacle Course

Your patrol must rely on one member who still has clear vision; he will talk you through an obstacle course in which you will be blindfolded. Watch out for the hazards. Clear instructions are needed.

## WHITE MOUNTAIN

### Pioneering Skills

During this event, members will demonstrate their knot tying skills. Each of the following will gain points for your patrol.

Square Knot

Tautline

Bowline

Timber Hitch

Additional points will be awarded for demonstrating the following, using lashings:

Ladder

Flag Pole

Tripod

## Dog Sled Races:

Races will be held for two separate categories:

- Under 14 years of age
- 14 years of age and older

Patrols will be a minimum of 4 boys and not larger than 8 in the patrol. One boy must ride in the sled during the sled race. All gear previously carried in the sled through the day may be removed prior to the race.

If wheels were added to aid the boys through the day, they must be removed prior to the race.

The sled race will be for Boy Scouts only.

Show your spirit and pride throughout the day.

Awards will be presented after all Troops have assembled in front of the flagpoles.
