Sign up for the newest Boy Scout Adventure- Pack and Paddle JLTC!

Pack and Paddle is an outpost adventure program that follows the JLTC syllabus. This exciting program is being held during the JLTC courses on June 20-26, June 27- July 3, and July 11-17 at Nims Lake, S bar F Scout Ranch.

During Pack and Paddle Scouts will practice low-impact camping, learn how to use a compass, develop leadership skills, hike, and canoe.

To be eligible to participate in the Pack and Paddle program a Scout must:

- Be 14 years of age by the camp date
- Have the Swimming merit badge
- Have attended long-term Scout camp for a minimum of two years
- Be First Class rank or higher
- Be a member of a troop whose Scoutmaster has completed the adult Boy Scout Leader Basic Training course
- Be a current or prospective junior leader recommended by his Scoutmaster
- Be currently registered as a member of the Boy Scouts of America



Scouts must be able to pack all equipment in their packs including food, crew gear, shelter, and personal items. Please take into consideration that this is a strenuous course when selecting.

To sign up for Pack and Paddle JLTC, complete the JLTC application and check the appropriate area. Space is limited to 24 scouts per course.
