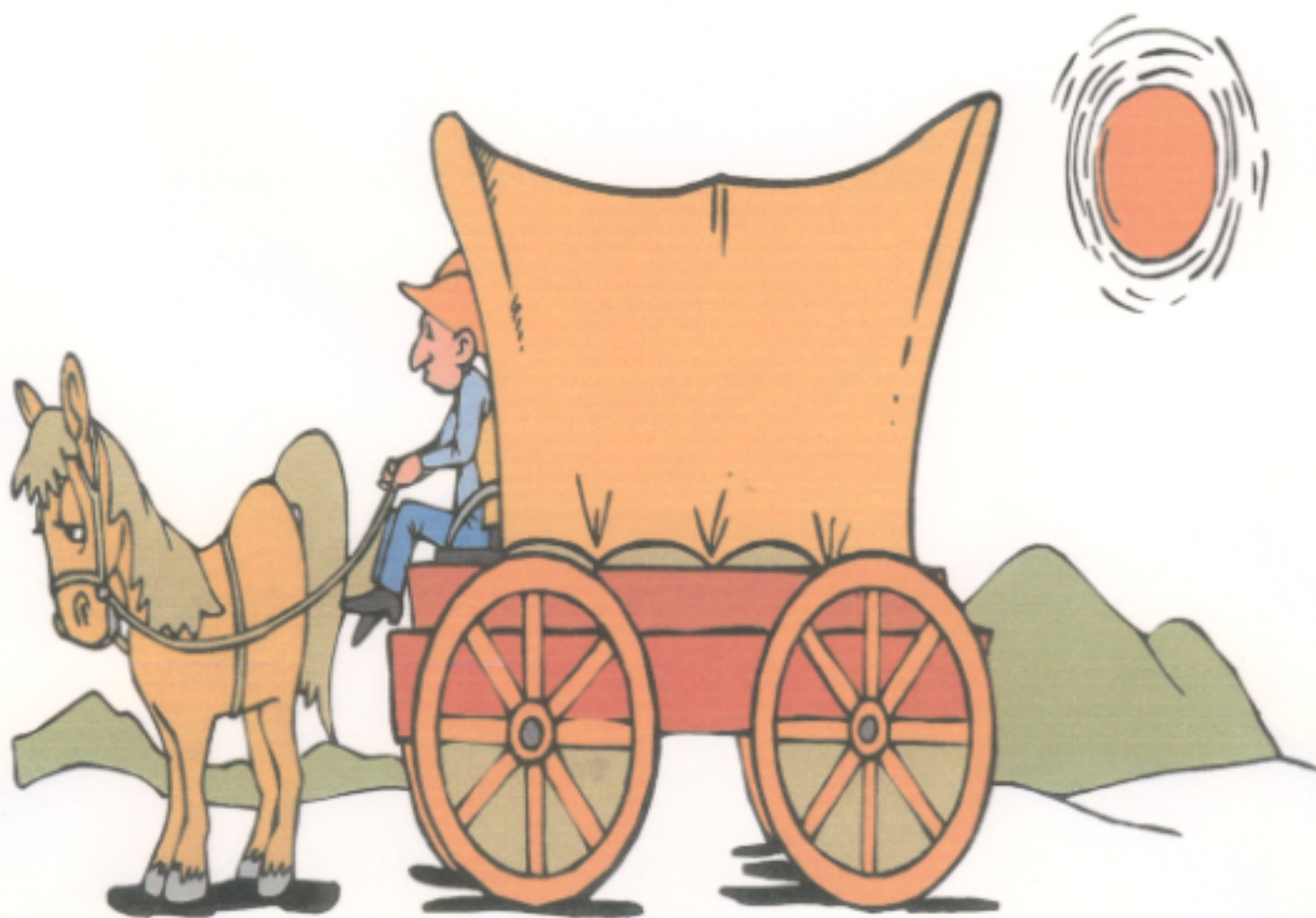

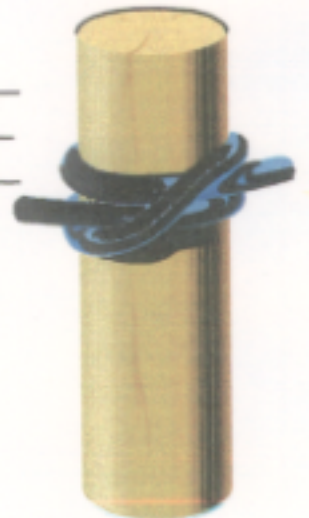

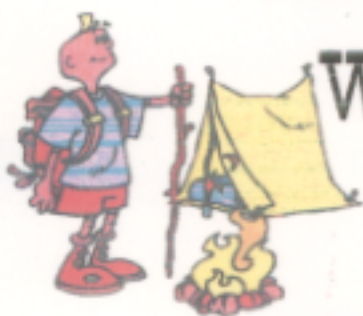

We will camp rain, shine or snow, because we'll be prepared.

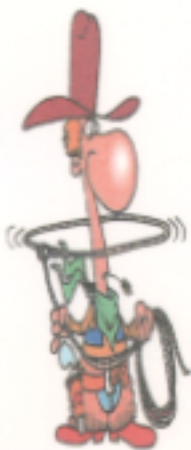
SCHEDULE OF EVENTS

 KEEP IT SAFE AND DRY.

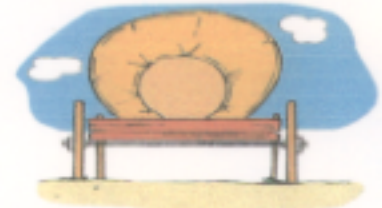


